## Summary of 2010 U.S. NIC Pavilion, Summit, and Commemorative Dinner

U.S. NIC hosted a U.S. Pavilion for more than a dozen U.S. nuclear organizations at the India Nuclear Energy expo in Goregaon during 7-9 October 2010. The U.S. Pavilion was inaugurated during a reception on 7 October 2010 that was hosted by Westinghouse and General Electric. The ANS/ASME U.S. Pavilion "Lounge" displayed information on more than 30 U.S. nuclear suppliers and organizations. ANS and ASME members distributed membership forms and promoted U.S. nuclear codes and standards.



DAE Summit featured speakers: Dr. R.K. Sinha, Director of Bhabha Atomic Research Centre; Hon'ble Union Minister of Power, Shri. Sushil Kumar Shinde, Government of India; and Dr. Srikumar Banerjee, Secretary of Department of Atomic Energy. U.S. speakers from GE, NuScale, and Westinghouse spoke on the CEO's Forum, Idaho National Laboratory spoke on human resources.



Hon'ble Union Minister of Power, Shri Sushil Kumar Shinde, Government of India commemorated the two-year anniversary of the Indo-U.S. Civil Nuclear Agreement with more than 50 senior officials of government and industry from both countries. U.S. Consul General Paul Folmsbee hosted the Minister and guests at his residence for a private dinner. The dinner was preceded by a signing ceremony for a memorandum of cooperation between the Indian Nuclear Society and the American Nuclear Society that had been approved by the Presidents and Vice-Presidents of the respective societies.

Guests included Government of India representatives of the Department of Atomic Energy, Nuclear Power Corporation of Indian Limited, Bhabha Atomic Research Centre and representatives of Indian industry included Hindustan Construction Company, Larsen & Toubro, J.M. Baxi, Walchanagar, Tata Power, DSK Legal, State Bank of India, Infosys and others. The event was co-hosted by KPMG and the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce, incoming IACC president Pradeep Udhas of KPMG introduced the Minister. U.S. Nuclear Infrastructure Council member companies General Electric, NuScale Power, Westinghouse, and Urenco/LES attended. Other U.S. representatives included the American Nuclear Society, American Society of Mechanical Engineers, Idaho National Laboratory, Holtec International, Marsh and McLennan Companies, Oak Investors, Vijay Technologies, Canberra, and Texas A&M University.
