2019 RICHARD (DICK) BENJAMIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



- Competitive scholarship, given in memory of Dr. Richard W. Benjamin, towards first-year of a Four-Year College or either year of a Two-Year Technical College Program – Scholarship Award Level will be \$2,500.
- **At least one Benjamin Technical College Scholarship and one Benjamin Four-Year College Scholarship will be awarded.**
- Seeking students with interest in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) careers, that are potentially interested in *Nuclear Science and Technology* fields.
- Current CSRA graduating high school seniors or first-year technical college students are eligible.
- Application window : January 7 – May 4, 2019; Awards: June 2019

Application Materials:

Cover letter including the student's name, address, evening phone number, current school, and home email address and name of college or technical school to which the Benjamin Memorial Scholarship would be applied. If the school is uncertain, then name the current top choice(s).

Application Evaluation Criteria

1. A one-page essay (300 words or less) on why a career in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, and particularly those in nuclear science, engineering and technology, is the goal of the student; (40%)
 2. High school transcripts (seven (7) semesters in the case of current high school seniors); plus first-semester transcripts for applicants who are first-year technical college students, along with their entire high school transcript; (20%)
 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation from education institution or community organization individuals (e.g., teachers, coaches, service or religious organization leaders, etc.). (Each recommendation is weighted 20%, or 40% for two recommendation letters)
