American Nuclear Society Michigan-Ohio Section Community College Student Scholarship Award

The Michigan-Ohio Section of the American Nuclear Society annually awards a nonrenewable scholarship of \$1000 to a student studying a nuclear-related field at a community college operating in the states of Michigan or Ohio.

To be considered for the award, the applicant must submit a written application. All applications should be submitted such that all components of the application package received no later than June 1, 2020. Applications received after June 1, 2020, will be refused, regardless of circumstances or transmittal mechanisms.

Electronic application submittal should be emailed to: ansmichigan@gmail.com. Acceptable electronic application document types include: MS Word, WordPerfect, and PDF.

A committee of Michigan-Ohio Section of the American Nuclear Society members will select the award recipient. The winner will be announced during the Summer and funds disbursed no later than the end of September. Each check is made payable to the recipient and mailed to the Department Head at the Community College the student will be attending. The student should contact the Department Head to arrange to pick up his/her award.

NOTE: The Michigan-Ohio Section of the American Nuclear Society reserves the right not to award the scholarship in the event it feels none of the applicants are qualified.

Rules

- 1. The applicant must enroll at, and attend, a Community College within the states of Michigan or Ohio during the Fall term the year that the award is given.
- 2. The applicant must be enrolled in an academic program leading to an associate's degree in a nuclear-related field in the academic year that the award will be received.
- 3. The applicant must fill out the attached application. Requested information such as copies of transcripts and the essay must be attached to the application. Reference letters may be sent in a sealed envelope with the application or, if absolutely necessary, mailed separately. The applicant must also submit an **essay**, no longer than two double-spaced typed pages, **describing what they see as their role in the future of nuclear technology**.
- 4. The criteria used to evaluate the applications include:
 - a. Academic accomplishments to date as indicated by a transcript showing subjects and grades.
 - b. Summary of capabilities and accomplishments as shown on the application form and reiterated by a minimum of two references (not family or friends).
 - c. Extracurricular activities including sports, clubs, student societies, student government, etc.
 - d. The essay will be evaluated on the basis of clarity and sincerity.
