Nuclear Industry Issues: A Commissioners Perspective

You are cordially invited to join the members of the Virginia section of the North American Young Gene Nuclear (NA-YGN), on October 8th 2002 at the Glen Allen Cultural Arts Center for dinner and to hear D Diaz, a Commissioner with the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC).

As a member of the Commission, Dr. Diaz participates in the exercise and direction of the Commission's licensi regulatory functions. His duties include policy formulation and rulemaking, as well as issuing regulations, relate and guidance for protection of the public health and safety, the common defense and security, and the environment of the public health and safety.

Commissioner Diaz' specific responsibilities include licensing the construction and operation of nuclear plants a nuclear facilities, such as nuclear fuel cycle facilities and test and research reactors, and renewal of operating lic these facilities, as well as oversight of their decommissioning. Commissioner Diaz is also responsible for licensi regulations for the possession and use of source, special and by-product nuclear materials, and is charged with solicensing responsibility for the construction, operation, and closure of the geologic repository for high-level radii wastes. During his tenure, Commissioner Diaz has been a strong advocate for streamlining the nuclear regulator framework with a strong focus on safety.
